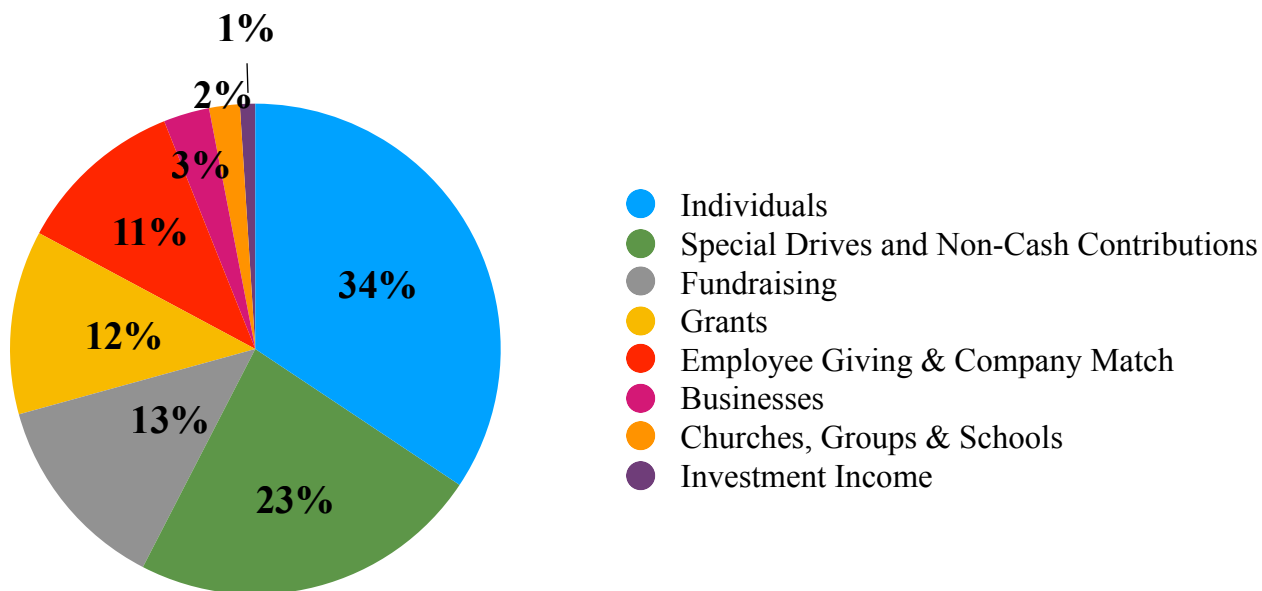
## DONATIONS
