What is T&E Care?

T&E Care is a group of community members who seek to help families living in and around Tredyffrin and Easttown Townships and have special financial and/or other needs (clothing, furniture, jobs, housing, etc.). We are all just folks who want to help others in our community who are working hard but still need support.

Why was it started?

After Hurricane Katrina destroyed much of the Gulf Coast area in September, 2005, some residents of Tredyffrin and Easttown decided to pool their resources to support any families who chose to relocate to this area. Requests for help were disseminated to friends and neighbors, and word spread quickly. The community was incredibly generous in supporting three families that eventually made their way to our area.

Throughout that fall community members worked hard to make these families feel at home by taking them shopping, helping the kids get enrolled in school and involved in local sports leagues, providing occasional meals, and generally being a support system for their everyday needs as they worked to put down roots in this area. After the holidays T&E Care was redirected as a group to help all local families needing a lending hand.

What is T&E Care's organizational structure?

There is a Board of Directors and an Auxiliary Board. T&E Care held its organizational meeting on February 23, 2006, at which time the Board of Directors agreed that it would work only with <u>unpaid</u> volunteers and that none of the directors or officers would receive a salary or any compensation for their time or services. We also agreed to work from our homes and not pay rental or utility fees for an office. We wanted all donations to go directly to the families we support.

How are requests identified?

T&E Care lends support to local families that need a little extra assistance when in a transition or difficult situation. We receive referrals from the school district, local churches, neighbors, and other local organizations such as Surrey Services. All requests for help are authenticated and in all cases we are very sensitive to confidentiality.

Can financial donations be made to T&E Care?

We always appreciate financial donations - that's how we pay bills for families. Donate with checks, paypal/credit cards or with venmo. Our website gives all the details.

Are donations to T&E Care tax deductible?

All donations are tax deductible to the fullest extent allowed by law. T&E Care is an IRS recognized non-profit under section 501(c)(3) of the tax code.

Do you want only donations of money?

No! School supplies, holiday gifts, computers, food, clothings, furniture, toys etc. are also periodically needed. We also take donations of cars! There are times when we need contacts for housing help, medical or legal advice, job support, etc. The T&E Care network is mobilized as needed to respond to specific requests within the community.

Do you do fundraising and grant writing?

Yes, we write grants and hold periodic fundraisers to help raise additional revenue. If you can lend a hand with these, please let us know!

Can anyone join T&E Care?

We are not a group that you actually "join", but we'd love to add your name to our email list. You will then be notified by email when needs occur or an event is happening. We never share our list with anyone else. You are never obligated to help out except when a situation touches your heart.

Are there any special T&E Care programs?

We have a number of programs that fall into two categories. These are more fully explained on our website, www.tecare.org/about/te-care-programs/
The categories and sample programs include:

Programs That Address Today's Needs Today

- •Home and Hearth We help pay rent/mortgage bills and make utility payments for families who face financial crisis and can't pay the bills.
- •Transportation Assistance We cover car repairs and inspections, and accept donated cars to give to local families in need.
- •Medical Assistance We help cover mental health counseling, medical and/or dental bills when insurance isn't an option.
- •Holiday Assistance We offer gifts, gift cards, and special dinners to families at the holidays to better allow our neighbors to enjoy this special time of year.
- •Kids' Clothing Event Once a year we collect gently used kids' clothing and make it available to community families.

Programs That Invest Today For A Better Tomorrow

- •College Assistance Program We offer funding assistance for students who are serious about their education. Help includes purchasing books, paying SAT or college application fees, assisting with tuition, and even buying some dorm room items. We also purchase new laptops for qualified freshmen to help them get started on an even playing field.
- •Summer Camp Program We help cover the costs of summer camp for kids who would otherwise not be able to attend.
- •School Supply Drive We provide school supplies for local families that struggle to afford them.
