### MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of T&E Care is to maintain a network of people providing financial and other material assistance to persons in need who live in and around the Tredyffrin and Easttown Township area.

### MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT & CHAIR OF THE BOARD

T&E Care marked 15 years as a community nonprofit organization in 2021. And while we continued to face the challenges of the pandemic, we received far fewer repeat requests for rent and food assistance than in 2020. Many still struggled, but not to the same level as the year before. We did provide increased support to a greater number of students through our College Assistance Program. Happily, our Camp Assistance Program returned to almost pre-pandemic levels. With continued community support, we were able to introduce two new programs that had an immediate and concrete impact on many families. Through our Dental Assistance Program, we paid for urgently needed dental care for over a dozen people who did not have dental insurance. Our PECO Assistance Program made supplemental utility payments in March and December for over 100 families. After 15 years, we continue to innovate and adapt to the changing needs of the families we support. As always, we are grateful for our continued ability to provide caring, confidential, and timely assistance to the Tredyffrin and Easttown community members we serve. - March 2022

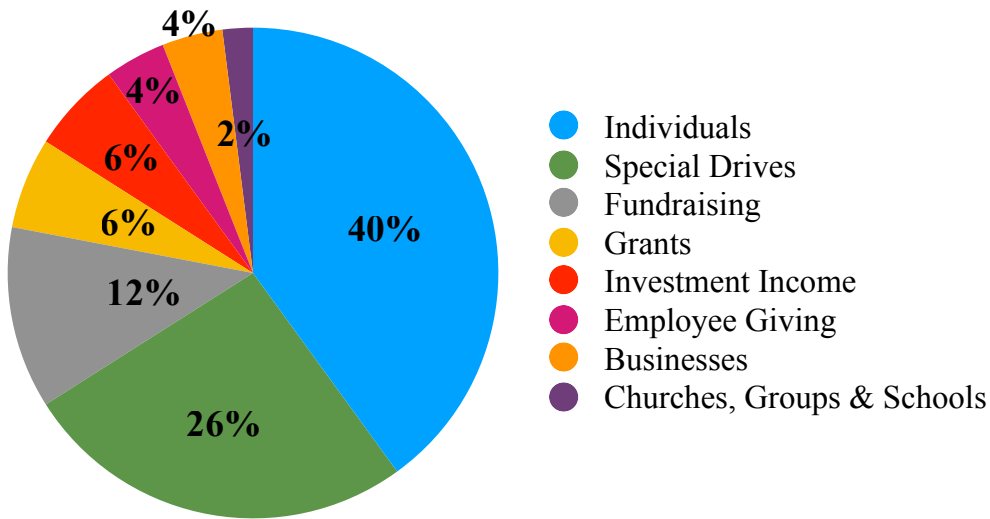
## DONATIONS
