MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT & CO-CHAIRS OF THE BOARD

T&E Care marked 16 years in 2022 as a community nonprofit organization. We would like to thank our outgoing Board Chairperson, Laura Pratt, for her dedication to T&E Care as well as the mentorship that she provided to so many current and former Board members.

While the obstacles presented by the pandemic in 2020-2021 have continued to recede, 2022 presented a new set of challenges with rising inflation. We saw increased prices on food, utilities, transportation and rent, with numerous families facing potential homelessness. Our continued commitment to annual programs including the School Supply Drive, Holiday Drive, Holiday Dinners, College Assistance Program and Camp Scholarships provided much relief for families. While we are fortunate to have generous donors who, despite the economy, continue to give toward the much-needed family assistance T&E Care offers, in 2022 we reached an inflection point for the first time in the history of our organization: community assistance requests exceeded community donations. We are grateful to be in a position to meet the needs of the community but are mindful of the need to focus on sustainability to continue to meet community needs for years to come.

SUPPORT


In 2022 our database of families we support grew by 20% to 311 families and we tailored our community assistance to combat the effects of the economic downturn and rising inflation. Total assistance increased \$38,000 (7%) over 2021, driven by escalating tuition costs for students benefiting from our College Assistance Program, higher demand for relief of rent and utility payments, and transportation assistance where three cars were provided to families. We also broadened support within our Summer Camp Program and School Supply Drive, expanding the camp benefit offered and increasing the student list, respectively.

VOLUNTEERS AND DONORS

A mainstay of our organization are the donations provided by our volunteers and the wider T&E Care community. In 2022 we received over 1100 donations of one sort or another - from major corporate assistance to an individual family that purchased a few notebooks for the school supply drive. Those 1100+ donations came from over 675 separate donors. Over 50% of our donors were repeats from past years. In addition to our drives and general donors, our community concert event in September was again supported by many incredible sponsors and attendees. It all adds up and makes such a difference!

T&E Care is built on the strong, lasting commitment of our volunteers. We were very happy to see so many of them face to face in 2022, after our past covid-related pivots. We went back to a more normal format for our School Supply Drive and Holiday Drive. On both our Boards and committees, many past volunteers continue to lend a hand, and a number of new volunteers have joined the organization. It is always amazing to see the generosity of the residents of Tredyffrin and Easttown in terms of both donations and volunteer efforts.
